Many classic adventure movies were shot on location in Kenya, including "The Snows of Kilimanjaro" starring Gregory Peck, "King Solomon's Mines" with Stewart Granger and Mogambo featuring Clark Gable and Ava Gardner. Joy Adamson's book "Born Free" was made into a hit movie filmed entirely on location in Kenya. The film's stars Virginia McKenna and Bill Travers went on to form a charity The Born Free Foundation which continues to support conservation work in Kenya. Hollywood's greatest tribute to Kenya came with 1985's "Out of Africa". Adapted from Karen Blixen's classic book, the film told the story of her life in colonial Kenya, with Meryl Streep in the lead role and Robert Redford playing her lover, Denys Finch Hatton. With stunning cinematography and a rich music score by John Barry, the film brought Kenya to audiences all over the world. A major box office hit, **Out of Africa** went on to win the Academy Award for Best Picture.

Kenya is a great destination for television wildlife productions. Many award winning wildlife series have been shot on location in Kenya by BBC Natural History, Discovery, Survival and other production houses. The Maasai Mara continues to be the backdrop for BBC's popular Big Cat Diary, following the lives of the reserves predators. Also the 2005 box-office hit "The Constant Gardener" was also filmed on location in Loiyangalani, a small town located on the south-eastern coast of Lake Turkana.

This 13-day Kenya Royal Safari offers the opportunity to explore a few of Kenya's remarkable wildlife sanctuaries and ample time to immersion into the unique geographical features and meet the locals. magnificent views of Mount Kenya, the club offers a unique blend of comfort, relaxation and adventure.

THE 13 –DAY KENYA SAFARI DAY TO DAY ITINERARY

Day 1: USA/London. Depart on an overnight Virgin Atlantic Airways to London, Heathrow Airport.

Day 2: London/Nairobi...Arrive London Heathrow Airport in the morning. In the evening board Kenya Airways overnight flight to Nairobi. *(Note: The layover at the airport may be long, thus may need a hotel dayroom to rest. Or you may opt to go to London a day earlier and overnight.)*

Day 3: Arrive Nairobi...Arrive Nairobi in the morning. After going through immigration and customs, proceed to arrivals where you will be met by To Africa Tours and Safaris representative and transferred to the Norfolk Hotel. Check-in and freshen up and relax from the long flight. *(meals on your own today).*

Accommodation: [Fairmont The Norfolk Hotel](#).....Fairmont The Norfolk Hotel has played a leading role in Kenya's colorful history, and continues to be one of Nairobi's finest and best-known luxury hotels.

Day 4: Sweetwater's/ OI Pajeta Conservancy..... After breakfast depart Nairobi and proceed north, driving through lush tea and coffee estates to Sweetwater's Tented Camp. Sweetwater's is located in OI Pejeta Conservancy. Arrive in time for lunch. After lunch visit the [Chimpanzee Sanctuary](#), a charming haven established by the Jane Goodall Institute to provide sanctuary to orphaned chimps, and the specially protected and fenced refuge of black rhino with its stunning forty specimens!



In the late afternoon you will experience your first game drive in the conservancy. Sweetwater's offer excellent game viewing. The camp has its own private waterhole and salt lick so guests are guaranteed unprecedented close encounters with wildlife. After the game drive return to the camp for dinner. There is an optional night game drive **(extra cost)** after dinner. **(Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Diner).** **Accommodation:** [Serena Sweetwater's Tented Camp](#)...Accommodation is provided in 39 luxuriously appointed tents. Each tent has a thatched roof, an en-suite bathroom and its own veranda with views over the waterhole. Full room service is provided. Guest room facilities include power

outlet for hair dryer, shaver, sockets (Hairdryer available on request from the Reception Desk). Laundry and valet services are provided. The camp prides itself on the quality of its cuisine offering a 5-course "table d'hôte" dining experience every night, and a selection of African, Asian, and International dishes.



Day 5: Fairmont Mount Kenya Safari Club

After breakfast drive to Fairmont Mount Kenya Safari Club. Rest of the day at your leisure to enjoy the clubs various facilities. There are many recreational activities available: horseback riding, golf, croquet, a putting green, a bowling green, table tennis, swimming, a beauty salon, an animal orphanage. **Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner**

Accommodation: [Mount Kenya Safari Club Fairmont Hotel](#) ...Built in 1959 as the private retreat of movie star

William Holden, the Safari Club has near-legendary status and is now in the hands of the Fairmont hotel group. The sprawling, resort like hotel is right on Mount Kenya's doorstep, with majestic views of its peaks. Upon arrival, you walk along the equator right on your way to the check-in desk. There are 100 acres of immaculately tended gardens spread on either side of the equator.



Day 6: Samburu Game Reserve ...

After breakfast drive further north to the semi-arid and rugged landscape of Samburu National Reserve Samburu

takes its name from the nomadic tribe who live throughout this area. Safari through Samburu, Buffalo Springs and Shaba is a rich and rewarding experience. Travelling along the banks of the Ewaso N'giro provides a fascinating


procession of varied species. Elephant come to the river to drink, and in the dry season, use their tusks to dig deep wells in the dry river beds. There are plenty of crocodiles here, and large specimens can be seen sunning themselves on sandbanks. The heavy traffic of game around the riverbanks means that Lions are commonly seen hunting here. The plains and surrounding hills are the best place to find gerenuk, Grevy's Zebra and cheetah. The rocky slopes of the Kopjes and hills are good country for Kudu and are home to several prides of lion. **Meals: breakfast,**



lunch, dinner

Accommodation: [Ashnil Samburu Camp](#) ...Ashnil Samburu Camp sits in Buffalo Springs Game Reserve which takes its name from an oasis of crystal clear water at the western end of the reserve.

Each of the 24 deluxe en-suite tents have a view of the Ewaso Nyiro River. Every spacious tent consists of a dressing area, sitting area, luggage rack and en-suite facilities to provide a memorable stay close to nature. The open sitting restaurant located in the main building, overlooks the Ewaso Nyiro River. There is a variety of menus to choose from but mainly oriental, international cuisine and a taste of African traditional dishes.



Day 7: Samburu Game ReserveEarly morning and late afternoon game-drives enable you to see wildlife unique to this arid yet beautiful part of Kenya. Optional activities include: guided nature walks and visit to Samburu villages.

Meal: breakfast, Lunch, dinner

Accommodation: Ashnil Samburu Camp

Day 8: Maasai Mara Game Reserve After an early morning game drive and breakfast you will say “kwaheri” (goodbye) to your driver/guide and board a light aircraft for your flight to Maasai Mara National Reserve (there is luggage restriction on this flight – 33 pounds. You will leave your extra luggage with your driver/guide to take it back to Nairobi and you will retrieve it when you return to Nairobi from Maasai Mara). On arrival at the airstrip you will be met by the driver/guide from the Fairmont Mara Safari Club. You will arrive in time for lunch. In the late afternoon proceed on a game-drive. The Mara is an awesome natural wonder, a place where Maasai warriors share the plains with hunting lions. It is the land of “Big-Six” (lions, hippo, rhino, elephants and buffalo and cheetah). Wildlife moves freely in and out of the reserve, and through neighboring Maasai lands. This unique co-existence of man and wildlife makes this Maasai land one of the world’s most unique wilderness regions. The Maasai regard themselves not just as residents of this area but that they are as much a part of the life of the land as the land is part of their lives. **Meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner.**

Accommodation: Mara Safari ClubSurrounded on three sides by the Mara River, Fairmont Mara Safari Club is the epitome of tented luxury. The main lodge at the center of camp hosts an indoor restaurant, bar and library with Internet access to keep the relatives up to date with safari adventures. A spacious outside deck overhangs the river and leads to a heated pool, complete with bar and private massage tents. Each tent consists of heavy canvas sides and roof mounted to a concrete foundation. Like most tents, you enter and exit through a zippered slit on the front of the tent. Each tent also has a large front porch with a view of the Mara River where hippos and crocs tend to hang out and wallow in the muddy waters. While the tents look pretty plain from the outside, once inside they reveal all the comforts of a **5-star hotel** including a roomy walk-in shower, separate toilet room, vanity and plush towels.



Day 9/10: Maasai Game Reserve

Spend 2 full days in Mara, awoken to the sounds of birds in these endless rolling plains dotted with acacia trees. The scheduled morning and afternoon game drives provide you with an excellent opportunity to photograph the abundant wildlife in this seemingly limitless game reserve. On one of the morning you may opt to go on the scheduled game drive or for optional an early morning hot air balloon safari (**extra cost -\$470.00 per person**). The balloon ride gives you a bird's eye view of the Mara plains before landing for a champagne breakfast in the bush. **Meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner: Accommodation: Mara Safari Luxury Tented Camp**

Day 11: Nairobi After breakfast and check out, transfer to the airstrip for your scheduled light aircraft flight to Nairobi Wilson Airport. Met on arrival and transferred to the Tamambo Karen Blixen Coffee Gardens for Lunch. After lunch, proceed on a visit to the Kazuri Bead Factory. The mission of Kazuri is to provide and sustain employment opportunities for disadvantaged women. The Factory employs over 370 women, mostly single mother. It is equipped with a Clinic, providing free medical care for the employees and their immediate family. Kazuri also absorbs 80% of the medical bills outside the Factory Clinic. Afternoon transfer to the Norfolk Hotel where you are booked for the night on bed and breakfast. Tonight dinner will be at the world famous Carnivore restaurant. **Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner. Accommodation: Fairmont Norfolk Hotel.**



Day 12: Depart Nairobi.... After breakfast proceed on a visit to the Daphne Sheldrick Orphanage which is strictly opened between **1100hrs to 1200hrs.** followed by a visit to the **Giraffe Center** where you will have the opportunity to hand feed giraffes up close and person on a raised platform. Lunch will be at a local Nairobi restaurant followed by final transfer to the airport for your outbound international flight. **Meals: Breakfast, Lunch**



Day 13 : London/USA ... Arrive London in the morning and connect your Virgin Atlantic Airways flight to USA, taking all the memories of Kenya to share with friends and family.

USEFUL INFORMATION FOR TRAVEL TO KENYA

USA citizens must possess a valid U.S. passport for travel to Kenya. It must be valid 6 months beyond your intended stay in Kenya and must have 2-4 completely blank pages facing each other. All USA citizens an entry visa to Kenya.

Visa Requirements:

1. Applications forms are completed online, which is accessed at this link: <http://kenyaembassy.com/dcservices/appforvisaonline.asp>
2. Every section of the application must be filled out! Incomplete application will not be processed.
3. Submit your original passport (Not photocopy) — along with the application form. Passport will be mailed back once your Visa has been processed.
4. Completed (Filled in) Application Form duly signed.
5. Copy of flight Itinerary/Letter from travel agent on company letterhead confirming booking.
6. Two Passport size photos (NB: Computer generated pictures are not acceptable)
7. Pre-paid self-addressed s return courier envelope for Fedex, Express Mail, Certified Mail or Priority Mail with delivery confirmation (Note: UPS, Metered stamps and Regular mail are not acceptable).
8. Please ensure that all your paperwork is well organized (i.e. photo stapled at the top left side of Application form, while your itinerary and application form are together

TRIP CANCELLATION, INTERRUPTION AND

MEDICAL INSURANCE: Purchase travel cancellation, interruption, loss of luggage and medical insurance is required of all safari participants to protect travel investment from any unforeseen emergencies before and during the trip. Please visit the following website for your trip cancellation, interruption and medical insurance needs [insure my trip](#).

TRIP CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS: All cancellation must be advised in writing, signed by the safari participant (s). Cancellation are effective on the day they are received by To Africa Tour and Safaris. The following cancellation charges will be payable to land only depending upon the number of days prior to departure date when To Africa Tours and Safaris receives your notice of cancellation.

- More than 90 days a cancellation fee of \$200 per person applies.
- 89 and 60 days a cancellation fee of 30% of the total cost of the safari applies
- 59 and 30 days 50% of the total cost of the safari applies
- Less than 29 days a cancellation of 100% of the total cost of the safari applies
- Cancellation penalties on airfare are additional to the land package and will depend on the type/class of airfare and individual airlines terms and conditions applicable.
- No refund for any unused portions of the tour program once tour has commenced.

HEALTH RECOMMENDATION: The following vaccinations are recommended: Tetanus, typhoid, polio, Hepatitis A&B. Consult your doctor or local health department, travel clinic or immunizations center. Also recommended is anti-Malaria medication. For more information on health in Kenya please visit [CDC](#) website

MONEY MATTERS: The official Kenya currency is Kenya Shilling. The written abbreviation is either KSh or using /= after the amount (500/=). Available in notes re 50, 100, 200, 500, 1000 shillings. Available coins are 1, 5, 10, 20, 50. Foreign currencies such as the USD, Euros and Sterling pound are widely accepted. However, please note that dollar bills printed before **2003** are not accepted in Kenya, as there was a large amount of illegal processing of dollar bills in the country during that time. High denomination notes may also not be accepted, so make sure that your money in small bills (\$1s, \$5s \$10s, and \$20s) and make sure they notes are new bills. The bill s should not be worn out or torn.

Foreign exchange and ATMs are found throughout Kenya's major city centers and shopping complexes. It is advised that you bring enough money to last you the duration of your trip. Although the dollar is accepted widely, large cities and lodges/camps, you can exchange some of your money into local currency at the bank at the airport on arrival or bureau de change. Some hotels/lodges/camp, will exchange the money, however you will not get a good rate.

Visa, MasterCard, Diners Club and American Express are accepted by most restaurants, shops and hotels. Proof of identity may be requested, so be sure to carry a passport or some form of photo identification at all times. It is difficult to pay by credit card outside Nairobi.

The recommended amount of money to bring in cash is between \$500—\$800.00 minimum in U.S dollars. This money should include your tips and gratuities. In hotels/Lodges/Camps you can leave U.S. dollars or Kenya Shilling.

ELECTRICITY :The electricity supply in Kenya is 220/240 v 50hz. Plugs are 3 point square. You will need to bring your own converter and adapter (universal adapter with square three prongs) for recharging camera batteries, hairdryers, and electric shavers. Or instead you can bring devices that use batteries to operate and a supply of batteries.

WHAT TO PACK FOR THIS TRIP: When packing keep in mind on international flights you are allowed one check-in luggage weighing 50 pounds. Your carry-on luggage only maximum of 13 pounds. (Please verify with individual airline for luggage requirements) On inter-park flights on safari you are allowed 33 pounds. Also while on safari the space in the vehicles is limited. It is recommended you use soft sided luggage /duffel bag with wheels which is easier to transport in safari vehicles and on inter-park flights. It is also advisable, in addition to your check-in luggage to bring a small carry-on bag with everything that is essential and valuable, such as camera equipment, you medications, important travel documents, passports, money etc. for more information and regulations regarding contents of carry-on luggage please visit this website <http://www.tsa.gov/travelers>.

Safaris are extremely informal vacations, so pack lightly. All the lodges allow casual clothing and traditional safari wear while dining. It is recommended you bring light weight comfortable washable clothes. Most lodges and camps will launder your clothes for free or a small fee (\$2 - \$3 per item) within 24-hours. Loose fitting, casual and comfortable clothing is recommended. Bright colors are not suitable for game viewing, and game drives are conducted in the early morning and late afternoon, which can be cold, especially in winter. Light cotton trousers or shorts and shirts (both long and short sleeved), comfortable walking shoes, windbreaker, sunhat.

The following is a suggested packing list Clothing

- 1 pair of comfortable walking shoes (i.e. sneakers, cross training or light hiking shoes)
- 1 pair of sandals or flip-flops
- 2-3 Casual, comfortable and loose fitting clothing in khaki, brown, beige, green and olive colors made of natural fabrics such as cotton
- 2-3 T-shirts and light tops
- 2-3 Long-sleeved shirts/blouses
- 2 pairs of shorts or 2-3 pairs light weight long pants that zip off for shorts
- 1 warm fleece or sweater

- 1 Swimsuit/bathing suite
- Cotton socks and underwears
- Pajamas/Sleepwear
- Hat and bandana
- Optional: lightweight jacket or windbreaker

Other Items

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Small flashlight
- Sunglasses, sunscreen and lip balm
- Insect repellent
- Contact lens solution, spare glasses and extra contact lenses, if applicable
- Money belt or waist pack for money, tickets and passport
- Lightweight day pack for carrying you camera and the camera accessories , sunscreen, binoculars etc. or lightweight camera vest
- Waterless anti-bacterial gel, hand wipes and Kleenex tissues
- Camera, plenty of film or memory cards, extra batteries and charger, if applicable
- UK plug adapter and transformer/voltage converter, if applicable
- Small battery operated alarm clock or watch
- Journal or notebook for recording daily observations and pens
- Snacks – nutrition bars, nuts, candy, etc.
- Zip lock bags for toiletries, camera equipment, snacks, etc. and small trash bags
- Personal toiletries
- Small medical kit that includes any basic remedies you may need, such as antacids, painkillers, anti-histamines and cold remedies. You will also need anti-diarrhea medication such as Imodium (adults only); anti malarial pills, cream for itches and rashes (i.e. Benadryl itch relief stick), band-aids, stomachache medicine (i.e. Pepto-Bismol), antibiotic ointment (i.e. Neosporin), multi-vitamins prescription antibiotic effective against a broad range of bacteria
